The background is pale green and the dimensions allowed are, unless stated otherwise, width 76cm (2'6"), depth 65cm and height 100cm.

An exhibit is plant material, with or without accessories. Backgrounds, bases, containers, drapes, exhibit titles and mechanics may always be included in an exhibit unless otherwise stated. Natural plant material means fresh, dried or preserved. All back drapes must be free standing. Artificially coloured plant material may be used unless otherwise stated in the schedule. The cut ends of all fresh plant material must be in water or water-retaining material. Succulents, cacti, moss and lichen, fruit, vegetables and long-lasting plant material which will remain turgid for the duration of the Show are excepted.

121. 'Tokyo'

An exhibit to incorporate chrysanthemum, the symbol of the Japanese Emperor and the Imperial family.

122. 'A Garden Gone to Seed'

An exhibit of natural plant material.

123. 'Glorious Greens' An exhibit of natural plant material featuring fresh foliage.

124. 'On the Seashore'

A petite exhibit of natural plant material not to exceed 25cm (10") in width and depth, height may be up to 37cm (14.5"). Can be made at home.

125. 'A Napkin Ring'

Decorated with natural plant material. A napkin to be included.
Width 46cm (18") Can be made at home.

126. 'Simplicity'

An exhibit in the contemporary style. Width 61cm, (2')

127. 'Name that Tune'

An exhibit of natural plant material. Title card to be included.

128. 'Farmers' Market'

An exhibit of natural plant material.

129. 'Dine in for Two'

A table centre to include a candle. Width 50cm (20").
